### History

International Community School (ICS) operates as a member of Network of International Christian Schools. The school began in 1993 with a handful of students. It is now approximately 400 students in grades Pre-K through 12. The school's stated mission is *"we are a caring community, committed to provide each student with a quality, holistic education that instills a biblical worldview, a love and respect for all cultures, a zeal for lifelong learning, and a passion for personal excellence."*

### Community

The city-state of Singapore is a center of commerce, banking, and shipping in Southeast Asia. The parents of ICS students come from a variety of occupations and ministries. ICS enrolls a significant number of international students, approximately 30% from families serving in religious occupations. Business, government, and professional expatriates make up the rest of the student body. Students from over 25 countries make up the student body with the majority from the US, Korea, Singapore and Indonesia.

### Extra-Curricular and Community Service

A small number of clubs and sports as well as drama opportunities are available for ICS students. Each ICS high school student takes part in community service days as a part of the regular curriculum. All of our students participate in *Week Without Walls*; a cross-cultural service trip into Indonesia, Thailand, China, Philippines, India, Malaysia, Sri Lanka and other countries throughout Southeast Asia.

### Accreditation

ICS is a private international school registered with the Singapore Ministry of Education and accredited by the US-based Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC) and the Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI).

### Academic Program

ICS offers an educational program based on the American model of education. The school year consists of two semesters beginning in mid-August and concluding in early June. The high school program is college preparatory and conducted in English. Several Advanced Placement (AP) courses are offered. Students in grades 10 and 11 are required to take the PSAT. The school has had one National Merit Scholar and several National Merit Commended Scholars and AP scholars since its inception.

### ICS Expected Student Outcomes

1. ICS Students will develop a knowledge and appreciation for God and His Word
2. ICS Students will appreciate the importance of practicing Biblical character qualities
3. ICS Students will demonstrate academic excellence through higher level thinking skills, quality written and verbal skills, and conflict resolution and leadership skills

5. ICS Students will live an energetic, wholesome, and productive life

### College Admissions

- Seniors are limited to a maximum of 7 college applications.
- 75% of the Class of 2010 were accepted into their first choice of university.
- Class of 2010 average financial aid package was \$17,500
- Class of 2010 College selections: 1 Canada, 1 Singapore, 1 Philippines, 1 Malaysia, 17 USA, 2 Gap Year
- 90% of graduates attend a 4 year university, or join the military within 8 months of graduation

## Advanced Placement

-AP courses are available for juniors and seniors. Sophomores can appeal to take an AP course

- **AP classes offered at ICS include:** *Chinese, Studio Art 2D/3D, U.S. History, English Literature, Calculus, Statistics and Psychology. Students can appeal to take a test without taking the class.*

-In 2010, forty ICS students took sixty-five AP exams. 89% of the scores were 3 or higher and 66% were a score of 4 or 5

- 91% of the Class of 2010 took at least one AP exam before graduating and 52% took at least two.
