

BIBLE STANDARDS:

B1. Students will develop a knowledge and appreciation of God and His word

- B1a. Students will understand that God is the source of all truth, based on His inspired word, the Bible. (John 14:6; John 17:17, 2 Timothy 3 v 16)
- B1b. Students will integrate the Bible into all aspects of life. (I Corinthians 10:31)
- B1c. Students will memorize selected bible passages. (Ps 119 v 9-11)

B2. Students will understand that a personal relationship with Christ is the only means of salvation. (John 3:16; I John 5:11-13)

B3. Students will understand the importance of biblical character, spiritual discipline, and growth in Christ. (I Timothy 4:12; II Timothy 3:14,15)

- B3a. Students will discern the importance of developing a godly self-image (Psalm 139:14; Ephesians 4:32)
- B3b. Students will develop the knowledge and character that will enable them to fulfill their role within God's plan. (Deuteronomy 6:6-7, Jeremiah 29:11)

B4. Students will develop necessary communication, conflict resolution, and leadership skills based on Biblical principles. (Ephesians 4:29; Matthew 18:15-17; Mark 10:42-45)

B5. Students will understand the biblical model of authority and respond to authority figures with respect and obedience. (Romans 13:1-7; Ephesians 5:22-6:9)

B6. Students will discern how best to contribute to reaching the world for Jesus Christ. (Matthew 28:18-20; Acts 1:8)
