

International Community School Parent Teacher Fellowship (PTF) Scholarship Award

Scholarship Criteria and Information

1. International Community School (ICS) Parent Teacher Fellowship (PTF) Scholarship Award recipients will be selected annually by the ICS PTF Scholarship Award Committee, after review of all application material. Academic and personal references, academic standing, extracurricular activities, community service, spiritual growth and a written essay will be considered in the selection process. Students who wish to apply must submit an application and all required information by the deadline. Recipients will be notified by phone call or letter no later than May 15.
2. Scholarship may be awarded only to ICS high school seniors who have been in attendance at the school for at least two semesters (including the current one) on a full-time basis.
3. Completed application forms with all supporting documentation must be submitted to the ICS PTF Scholarship Award Committee by April 1, 2011. No late applications or parts of the application packet will be accepted.
4. The award must be used within two years of graduation, and only for academic purposes such as tuition, fees, room, board, and/or books.
5. The award will be paid directly to the educational institution selected by the applicant (either an accredited four-year institution or an accredited two-year vocational institution/community college).
6. Two awards will be offered annually. The award amount will be set at S\$750 per award. The PTF reserves the right to increase or decrease the amount awarded.
7. The ICS PTF reserves the right to determine if an award will be given.
8. Relatives of the current ICS PTF Award Committee are ineligible.
9. Students must be in good academic standing, having a minimum of a 3.0 cumulative high school grade point average when the application is made.
10. Decisions of the Award committee are final in all matters related to the above practices.
