



BUS GUIDELINES for students riding the school bus

(this form needs to be signed and sent to the office the first week of school)

It is the primary duty of the drivers and Goh Transport Services to provide safe, efficient transportation for students of ICS to and from school. Certain guidelines must be adhered to in order to make that possible. Following is a list of guidelines for students using Goh Transport Services both to and from school.

Students are to be at their pick-up point 3-5 minutes prior to their scheduled time. If a student is not at their pick-up point, the driver will wait only 2 minutes before proceeding on with the established route. If a student will not be riding the bus to school and the driver has not been notified, the parent/maid should wait at the pick-up point so the driver is not unduly delayed. If the student is not riding the bus in the afternoon the bus company and the school office needs to be notified in advance.

Students should:

1. Show respect for the driver as well as other students.
2. Remain seated with seat-belts on at all times.
3. Have no body contact with other students on the bus. No fighting, pushing, kicking or playing with toys or other objects. Inappropriate behavior is not allowed.
4. Keep all food and drinks in their lunch bag. (Water is permitted.)
5. Keep papers in their book bag. (No littering.)
6. Talk QUIETLY. No bad language is allowed at any time.
7. Keep hands and head inside the window.
8. Keep the aisles clear of books, bags, etc.
9. If disembarking remain seated until the bus has stopped.
10. Walk when getting on and off the bus.

Any serious violations of the above guidelines will result in the student being suspended from the privilege of riding the bus for 3 days. The safety of all the children is at stake.
