

The admissions requirements for each course (grade level) for students without a learning support plan K4-Grade 5 are listed below. Admissions requirements for each course (grade level) for students with a learning support plan can be adjusted by the elementary principal if ICS is able to accommodate for the student's learning needs.

Requirements for each course (grade level) for admission for ALL students for entrance into Grade 6.

AMERICAN CURRICULUM (ELEMENTARY KINDERGARTEN) - KINDERGARTEN 5	Age: 5 Academic level: Pre-school experience highly recommended Language proficiency: Some English language vocabulary needed
AMERICAN CURRICULUM (ELEMENTARY) - GRADE 1	Age: 6 Academic level: American Curriculum Elementary Kindergarten or acceptable equivalent; must successfully pass English and Math from Kindergarten Language proficiency: Completion of American Curriculum Elementary Kindergarten in English or with ESL help
AMERICAN CURRICULUM (ELEMENTARY) - GRADE 2	Age: 7 Academic level: American Curriculum Elementary Grade 1; must successfully pass English and Math from Grade 1 Language proficiency: Completion of American Curriculum Elementary Grade 1 in English
AMERICAN CURRICULUM (ELEMENTARY) - GRADE 3	Age: 8 Academic level: American Curriculum Elementary Grade 2; must successfully pass English and Math from Grade 2 Language proficiency: Completion of American Curriculum Elementary Grade 2 in English
AMERICAN CURRICULUM (ELEMENTARY) - GRADE 4	Age: 9 Academic level: American Curriculum Elementary Grade 3; must successfully pass English and Math from Grade 3 Language proficiency: Completion of American Curriculum Elementary Grade 3 in English

AMERICAN CURRICULUM (MIDDLE SCHOOL) - GRADE 8	Age: 13 Academic level: American Curriculum Middle School Grade 7; must successfully pass Grade 7 English and a math course equivalent to or higher than Math Course 2 Language proficiency: Completion of American Curriculum Middle School Grade 7 in English
AMERICAN CURRICULUM (HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA) - GRADE 9	Age: 14 Academic level: American Curriculum Middle School Grade 8; must successfully pass Grade 8 English and a math course equivalent to or higher than Pre-Algebra Language proficiency: Completion of American Curriculum Middle School Grade 8 in English
AMERICAN CURRICULUM (HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA) - GRADE 10	Age: 15 Academic level: American Curriculum High School Grade 9; must successfully pass: Grade 9 English; a math course equivalent to or higher than Pre-Algebra; and have 5 academic credits Language proficiency: Completion of American Curriculum High School Grade 9 in English
AMERICAN CURRICULUM (HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA) - GRADE 11	Age: 16 Academic level: American Curriculum High School Grade 10; must successfully pass: Grade 10 English; a math course equivalent to or higher than Algebra 1; and have 12 academic credits Language proficiency: Completion of American Curriculum High School Grade 10 in English
AMERICAN CURRICULUM (HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA) - GRADE 12	Age: 17 Academic level: American Curriculum High School Grade 11; must successfully pass: Grade 11 English; a math course equivalent to or higher than Geometry; and have 18 academic credits <i>with the ability to fulfill the remaining 7 credits required for graduation within the Grade 12 school year</i> Language proficiency: Completion of American Curriculum High School Grade 11 in English

In addition to the chart above, admission to each module in the high school is based on successful completion of the prerequisite module indicated within the syllabus for that module. Prerequisites are identified based on required knowledge necessary to be successful in the course.
